Since its incorporation as a 501(c) (3) nonprofit public benefit corporation in September of 1985, the TCAC has coordinated, sponsored, funded, produced, and participated in hundreds of local arts events. It is governed by an all volunteer 15 member board and we rely on donations and membership dues to sponsor and encourage individuals and organizations in the promotion and development of the arts in Tehama County.
