The TCAC was established in 1982 by the Tehama County Board of Supervisors to promote visual and performing arts as well as other cultural endeavors in Tehama County.

Since its incorporation as a 501(c) (3) nonprofit public benefit corporation in September of 1985, the TCAC has coordinated, sponsored, funded, produced, and participated in hundreds of local arts events. It is governed by an all volunteer 15 member board and we rely on donations and membership dues to sponsor and encourage individuals and organizations in the promotion and development of the arts in Tehama County. With your membership you will receive four quarterly printed newsletters, receive monthly arts e-newsletters, support such artistic events as the annual Missoula Children's Theatre, the Tehama County Student Art Contest, and the Downtown Red Bluff ArtWalk, have the use of our art display boards when available, be able to use the Artists' Referral Service on our website, and be a part of sponsoring grants to local artists and art organizations.
