It is governed by an all volunteer 15 member board and we rely on donations and membership dues to sponsor and encourage individuals and organizations in the promotion and development of the arts in Tehama County. California Arts Council Announces Arts License Plate Fees Are Now Charitable Deductions, Launches Goal of One Million New Arts License Plates On California Cars

Funds Will Take California to Top in Arts Programming Funding

A recent clarification from a state tax agency could be a significant boon for the arts in the state. California Arts license plate fees are charitable deductions to the state of California for tax purposes according to the Franchise Tax Board, The clarification comes just in time for the holidays and end-of-the-year charitable planning and serves as a platform to launch a goal of affixing one million new arts plates to California cars.
