

Contest Rules:

- 1) The theme for the 2010 contest is “**Magnificent Machines,**” with an optional sub-theme for Divisions 1 and 2: “Robots.”
- 2) Any medium may be used. Artwork must be the student’s original and creative creation, and may not be traced or copied from other work.
 - Classroom projects are encouraged but each submitted artwork should be unique.
 - Computers or other devices may not be used.
 - Adults may provide only guidance and encouragement to the artist and may not assist with the actual artwork.
- 3) Entries must be no larger than 9 x12 inches, should not exceed ¼ inch in total thickness, and should not be matted or framed.
- 4) Only one (1) entry may be submitted per student.
- 5) **The entire entry form must be completed, signed and glued to the back of each student’s artwork.**
- 6) Entries will be judged by the Red Bluff Art Association on originality, creativity, interpretation of theme and quality of work. Points will be deducted if rules are not followed.

Awards and Prizes

Entries will be awarded 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place ribbons by the RBAA and prizes in each of the four divisions by the TCAC:

Division 1: Grades K-2

Division 2: Grades 3-5

Division 3: Grades 6-8

Division 4: Grades 9-12

The TCAC will present a \$50 cash award for Best of Show. All participants will receive a certificate of participation. Points will be deducted if the rules are not followed and if the entry form is not completely and clearly filled out.

Exhibit and Artist’s Reception

All entries will be displayed at the Tehama District Fairgrounds on Saturday, October 9, 2010 between 9 AM and 1 PM in association with the Sacred Heart School’s Calico Faire and the St. Elizabeth Community Hospital’s Health Spree. Division winners and the Best of Show will be announced and receive prizes at the Young Artist’s Reception, 12 PM on Saturday, October 9 at the Tehama District Fairgrounds (Home Arts Building), hosted by the TCAC and Sacred Heart School (SHS).

All non-winning entries will be returned to SHS on Tuesday, Oct. 12. We ask that the artwork be picked up at SHS between Oct. 12 and Oct. 15 by the person who originally delivered the artwork to SHS. The winning entries will be displayed for two weeks (Oct. 11-23) at The Big Picture, 857 Washington St. Red Bluff, then will be displayed at the Tehama County Department of Education’s gallery from October 26 to November 30. Following this display artwork will be returned to SHS along with any unclaimed awards. We ask that the winning entries be picked up at SHS by the individual winners between Dec. 2-8. Thanks to *The Big Picture* for matting all the winning entries and framing the Best of Show.
