Art with luminosity will be highlighted in the Blacklight Night Art show. All art needs to be brightly saturated color mediums that are neon or glow in the dark colors, UV/Blacklight reactive, or by using the Chromadepth technique, which can be applied to any color medium from crayons to digital art & photography, which allows 3D images to be created.

The Chromadepth technique enables the creation of normal looking brightly colored images. But when viewed through special inexpensive Chromadepth glasses the images appear 3-Dimensional, with each color moving either to the foreground or to the background. On a black background, red appears closest, blue the farthest and other colors fall in between, arranged according to their place in the rainbow.
